

**RULES & FORMAT OF THE
10th AUSTRALASIA JASS TOURNAMENT
HAMILTON NZ
Saturday 5th of June 2021**



- Schieber Variation of Jass, played with German cards (Schelle, Schilte, Eichle, Rose)
- Each player is assigned a randomly selected number
- Randomly chosen different partner for each round
- 10 Rounds of 8 Games or Hands, each Game or Hand = 157 points
- Obenabe with Ass = 11 points, 8 = 8 points, 6 = zero points
- Undenufe with 6 = 11 points, 8 = 8 points, Ass = zero points
- Trump: Under = 20 points, Nell = 14 points
- Last trick = 5 points
- No points for Stöck, Wiis or Match
- Each Round has a combined total of 1,256 points
- Two players may share play during day
- Each player has to fill out his personal MY SCORE sheet after each Game or Hand and add up the Total Score for the 8 Hands played per Round
- The TABLE SCORE Card has to be completed for every Round. Enter the Names of the Players and the Total Score for each Team for the Round into the TABLE SCORE Card.
- All 4 players must accurately record the scores and cross check every Game entry and the Totals for the Round
- A wrong card on the table (either time-wise or suit-wise) can be taken back, but, that card is rendered invalid and will not take any more trick
- The partner of the one who announces 'Trump or Schiebe' can look at his/her cards only once the announcement of 'Trump or Schiebe' has been made
- No signs or talk during the game; discuss strategies before dealing

**IN CASE THERE IS AN UNEVEN NUMBER OF REGISTERED PLAYERS, WHICH IS NOT
DIVISIBLE BY FOUR - THE FOLLOWING APPLIES:**

- Randomly chosen players will get a "bye" for a maximum of one round.
- Players who have a bye receive 628 points for that round
- In this case, the lowest score of any one round of each player will be deducted from the total championship score.
- However, total championship points before deductions will be kept for comparison & statistical purposes.
